

# Study Abroad - Spain 2015!



## Spend four weeks in Spain at the Universidad de Alcalá at the Instituto Franklin!

**What are we doing in Spain?** students will attend lectures, visit local schools, and take educational field trips. ISU faculty will be teaching on site. Students will study a combination of Spanish language and culture, and can earn up to **30 clinical hours**. This program is designed for **all Education Majors**, and there is **no Spanish language requirement**. There are also several cultural activities included in the cost of the program. Faculty will accompany students during the four week program.

### Do I need to speak Spanish to apply?

No language is required! If you do not speak Spanish, you can still participate. Language immersion is possible since you will live with a Spanish family.
